Where Do My Dues Go?

- † Revenue from membership dues and activities is used to purchase flowers, to clean or purchase altar linens, and other Parish items as needed or requested by the Pastor.
- † The purchase of member masses, cards, postage for mass mailings, etc.
- † The purchase of greatly needed items for the parish as designated by the Pastor.

What Are Our Members' Benefits?

- † A Mass is offered each month for all living and deceased Guild members-past and present.
- † A Corporate Communion Mass on the Third (3rd) Sunday of the month at 10:00 AM, before our meeting. The Guild doesn't meet in the months of June, July or August.
- † A Mass is offered for a member who has died during the year.
- † Cards of "Condolence" and "Get Well" wishes are sent out to Parishioners.
- † An Annual Communion/Membership Luncheon is held, usually in February, to renew membership, recruit new members, install new officers and gather together.
- † A feeling of satisfaction in knowing you supported Parish functions in some way.
